

## One Evening Beret

Material: 1 - 50 gram skein of mohair ( about 100 yards.)

Sizes 4 and 10 circular needles 16" to 24" in length.

Size 10 dpn.

Pattern:

Using smaller size needles cast on 64 sts., join being careful not to twist cast on. Place marker on needle to mark the beginning of each round.

Work in k1, p1 rib for 1 inch.

Increase round: \*k1, inc in next stitch by knitting in front and back of stitch, repeat from \* around. 96 sts.

Change to larger circular needles and work in st.st. (knit every stitch in every round) until total length is 5 1/2".

Begin decreasing for crown - Change to dpn needles when necessary.

Rnd 1: \*place marker, knit 12, repeat from \* to end of round. 96 sts.

Rnd 2: \* knit 10, k2tog, repeat from \* to end of round. 88 sts.

Rnd 3: knit

Rnd 4: \* knit 9, k2tog, repeat from \* to end of round. 80

sts.-----

Rnd 5: knit.

Rnd 6: \* knit 8, k2tog, repeat from \* to end of round. 72 sts.

Rnd 7: knit.

Rnd 8: \* knit 7, k2tog, repeat from \* to end of round. 64 sts.

Rnd 9: knit.

Rnd 10: \* knit 6, k2tog, repeat from \* to end of round. 56 sts.

Rnd 11: knit.

Rnd 12: \* knit 5, k2tog, repeat from \* to end of round. 48 sts.

Rnd 13: \* knit 4, k2tog, repeat from \* to end of round. 40 sts.

Rnd 14: \* knit 3, k2tog, repeat from \* to end of round. 32 sts.

Rnd 15: \* knit 2, k2tog, repeat from \* to end of round. 24 sts.

Rnd 16: \* knit 1, k2tog, repeat from \* to end of round. 16 sts.

Rnd 17: \* k2tog, repeat from \* to end of round. 8 sts.

Cut yarn leaving a 10" tail. Thread yarn through a darning needle and run thread through remaining 8 sts. Pull tight and fasten off. Weave in ends.
